3.	Short term goals (To be achieved by 2021)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Up-gradation of Fishing Jetty at Khariwada, Vasco – for safety of fishermen and reduce post harvest loss. 2. To provide Kissan Credit Card to 1000 nos. fishermen and fish farmers. 3. To provide bio toilets to 100 trawlers/ Purseiners. 4. To register all fish traders at Jetty. 5. To cover 2000 fishermen under insurance scheme. 6. To provide 10 Lakhs fish fingerlings to fresh water fish farmers. 7. To provide 10 nos. motorcycle & Three wheelers with ice box. 8. To Re-register all fishing nets. 9. To provide financial assistance to 100 fishermen to install AIS on fishing vessel.
4.	Medium term goals (To be achieved by 2023)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To install CCTV Cameras at four Jetties and at sub-offices. 2. To construct two Retail fish market & ten mobile fish kiosk. 3. To encourage deep sea fishing. 4. To upgrade Infrastructure facilities at fish landing centres, Ramps, etc 5. Construction of fishing ramp Muxem, Velim for traditional fishermen to land and berth the fishing vessel (canoe). 6. Up-gradation of Ramp and Net mending shed at Talpona, Canacona. 7. Strict enforcement of Marine Fishing Regulation (MFR) Act, 1980 under rules 1982 against the violators. 8. To provide financial assistance to minimum two ice plants. 9. To modernize existing ice plants.

Construction of Vasco fishing harbor at Mormugao. 3. To develop Ice Storage and Cold Storage facilities. 4. To provide financial assistance to SGPDA wholesale fish market at Margao. 5. Setting up Fin Fish and Shrimp Hatchery through PPP at Benaulim.
